HOST STATE REPORT

The 2008 School Sport Australia Football Championships were an outstanding success in all aspects, with all games being played in an excellent spirit. Competitors and team management are to be congratulated on their co-operation and assistance during the week, both at the venue and in the Port Macquarie community. The standard of competition was extremely high with many favourable reports regarding the behaviour of the team members being received by the local organizing committee.

Date and Venue

The 2008 School Sport Australia Football Championships were conducted from 3 - 8 August 2008 at the Port Macquarie Regional Stadium (NSW). The venue had two (international) full sized fields available for competition as well as ample warm up areas. The main stadium provided excellent amenities for all facets of the championship. Evening fixtures were also a feature of the championship.

Teams Competing

The championships featured representation from the following states and territories:- Queensland (Boys and Girls), New South Wales (Boys and Girls), Australian Capital Territory (Boys and Girls), Victoria (Boys and Girls), Northern Territory (Girls), South Australia (Boys and Girls), and Western Australia (Boys and Girls).

Congratulations are extended to the 2008 winners; New South Wales in the girls and New South Wales in the boys.
